
DIAGNOSTIC SCREENS



Refer to the Valid Slide System operation guide for more information about diagnostic screens.

Overview

Each room has two slide motors, an air manifold, and a pneumatic weather seal.

It may also have an optional elevating floor with its own motor.

The slide controller is normally operated with a touchscreen.

The system may also be manually overridden if necessary, with guidance of qualifed service personnel.

Status Indicators


Room: Retracted, Mid-Position, or Extended


Seal: Inflated, Vented, or Vacuumed

Floor: Lowered, Mid-Position, or Raised

Typical Operations

- The seal is always vented and vacuumed prior to slide movement.
- If the seal is inflated, the slide is prevented from moving.

QUICK REFERENCE CARD

It is recommended that you read and understand the operation manual before operating the Valid Slide System.


Before Using the Valid Slide System


- 1. Ensure the coach's air system is at full pressure.
- 2. The ignition MUST be on, and if possible, have the engine running to ensure sufficient air supply for slide operation.
- 3. Ensure that the area around the coach is clear of obstructions.
- 4. Set the park brake.
- 5. Touch the screen to activate the display, if necessary.



DEFLATE THE AIR SEALS

Press **Deflate Seals** to prepare all slides for extension or retraction.






Wait for Auto Deflation to complete. Then press Room Select.

SELECT THE ROOM SLIDE

If the coach has more than one slide, select the slide you wish to extend or retract.




Select one

EXTEND THE ROOM SLIDE

To extend the room, press and hold **Extend**.


Release button when prompted

NOTES


- If a slide is in motion, it may be stopped at any time by releasing the Extend / Retract button.
- If a slide is not moved, its seal will automatically inflate again 10 minutes after auto-deflation is complete.
- The Inflate Seals button will automatically revert to **Deflate Seals** after auto-deflation is complete.

RETRACT THE ROOM SLIDE

To retract the room, press and hold **Retract**.

Remember

Ensure that the Extend / Retract button is pressed and held during extension / retraction. Release the button when prompted to do so.

BEFORE TRAVEL

Before the coach can travel, all slides must be fully retracted with their pneumatic weather seals inflated.

If this is not the case, "Vehicle Travel Disabled" is displayed.
